

Letter 'A' Day

- When:** Friday 8th of June 2018
- Dress Up:** Students are encouraged to dress up as something that begins with the letter A:
Athlete, Angel, Animal, Avengers, AFL player etc.
- Start Time:** Fun Run will start at 2.00 pm
- Where:** Begin at school, run along the walking/bike track towards the jetty, beach and then back to school
Year R to 5 students will be running from the school to the jetty and back to school via the beach
Years 6-10 (year 4/5 students can choose which track they would like to follow) will follow the walking trail, past the jetty, to the Anxious Bay road and back along Milligan's Beach, past the jetty to the front beach and back to school.

- Safety:** Staff will be present where students are to cross any major roads and at the jetty, where a drink station will be situated.
