





Art Versus Science ... or is it Spanish??

As part of Science Week, Students at EAS discovered the <u>non-porous properties</u> of glass through experimenting with <u>mono-printing</u>. This is a process where paint is applied to a <u>non-porous surface</u> such as glass or <u>acetate sheets</u> (thick <u>transparent</u> plastic sheets used for printing) and then a single print taken off the glass with <u>lithograph paper</u>. The effect is a <u>textured print</u> which can then be used for <u>mixed media</u> artwork.

R/1 students used their <u>mono-prints</u> to learn the Spanish names for marine and desert animals and create <u>mixed media art</u> using black markers or <u>collage</u>.
