Today our staff spent the day interacting with a Power of Metalinguistic Understanding workshop by Damon Thomas, Senior Lecturer in Literacy Education, University of Queensland. Damon provided an insight into metalinguistic understanding – knowledge of how language works to achieve an intended purpose. He explained the essential grammar knowledge we need to implement the curriculum effectively and provided practical strategies for building our students' metalinguistic understanding.

We also participated in a session with Sarah Rowntree: Writing Improvement Project Officer on moving from providing specific feedback about a targeted writing skill into a Teaching and Learning cycle. She also exposed our staff to the NEW Writing Best Advice papers, the importance of specific feedback and what peer and self-assessment could look like in our classroom settings. Both sessions were beneficial in upskilling our staff on important knowledge and skills as we successfully implement our Site Improvement Priorities throughout the school.

Emergency Service Visit

Last Tuesday it may have seemed like there had been a serious incident taking place on our school oval, however, please rest assured it was only a visit from our local emergency services vehicles and volunteers. The students in the junior primary classes were treated to a detailed examination of the special features of the vehicles and were even able to have a go at some of the specific techniques. A huge thank you to our local Ambulance and CFS volunteers and the Kindy staff for considering our students in such a positive learning experience.

Educational Standards Board Visit

Last week we welcomed a visit from the Educational Standards Board who undertook a validation review of registration. As a school we were delighted to provide evidence across three standards:

Standard 1 – School Governance

Standard 2 – Student Learning and Assessment

Standard 3 – Student Safety, Health and Welfare

The Standards board team were thrilled with our thorough evidence in each area and although they will provide some recommendations, once we submit the final aspects, will remain registered as a quality education provider.

Leaders Day

Last Monday I attended the 2022 Leaders Day in Adelaide. This was an event that brought together Principals from across the state and we were excited to listen the ideas of our new, Minister for Education, Training and Skills, Hon Blair Boyer and our newly appointed CE, Professor Martin Westwell. Both speakers outlined their vision for education in South Australia and presented a clear path forward in a transition from a World Class to World Leading.

I was also delighted to attend several master classes presented by high functioning schools and hear from their Principals and leadership teams about the improvement journeys they have been on. They drew conclusions on some of the critical leavers that bring about the positive improvement for student learning.

Eligible organisations can now apply for funding through the **Active State Collaboration Program (ASCP)**.

ASCP is a new grant program looking to drive sport and recreation initiatives, through funding that rewards organisations partnering to develop and deliver projects to get more South Australians active.

The program will support projects that align with the Government's priorities and the [ORSR 2021–2025 Strategic Plan](#) that provides everyone with an opportunity to participate in sport and active recreation.

Applicants will be required to demonstrate how their project will contribute to one or more of the following strategic priorities:

1. **Active Lives** – Movement, play and performances is embedded into the daily lives of South Australians.
2. **Places and Spaces** – Places and spaces that encourage and support movement, play and performance are accessible to all. (Please note this is in relation to addressing activation, accessibility, and programming – infrastructure development projects are ineligible).
3. **Strategic Partnerships** – Community outcomes are delivered through strategic partnerships.

With over \$2.6 million on offer, the funding is available to not-for-profit organisations that have been operating for at least 12 months and local councils.

Applicants may request up to \$500,000 per project and will be required to have a level of co-investment, which will form part of the assessment.

Please read the Program Guidelines prior to submitting an application.
