# 7/8 Science Mr Baccanello



As part of the current Year 7/8 Science unit which is titled "Properties of Matter", we learnt how to calculate the density of both regular and irregular objects.

We applied the formula

#### Density = Mass (g) / Volume (cubic cm).

We used electronic scales to measure mass and a ruler to calculate the volume of regular objects such as wood and metal blocks. By observing water displacement, we were able to measure the volume of irregular objects. We have also learned how to create solutions with different percentages of salt concentration using scales and measuring cylinders.

The summative assessment that we are currently working on requires us to formulate an investigation that allows us to identify solutions in
