## Dates to Remember

**Surf Competition** 8<sup>th</sup> of May Elliston Area

Hello everyone and welcome to Term 2. I hope all students were able to have a restful holiday and are ready for an exciting term of learning. We look forward to hearing about the student's holiday adventures.

This Term we will continue to focus on our SIP priorities of Reading and Writing Improvement. Each student has been assigned reading and writing goals that will be communicated with families during interviews. Staff are regularly undertaking reading and writing conferences with the students to provide feedback in line with their goals and to move everyone's learning forward. Accompanying these two strategies is the explicit teaching of the Big 6 of reading (oral language, phonological awareness, phonics, vocabulary, fluency and comprehension), language conventions (spelling, grammar, punctuation, and sentence structure) and genre writing.

Families can also continue the development of these two important areas by promoting both reading and writing at home. Listening to your child read on a regular basis is vital, as is asking them questions about what they are reading and prompting the joy and entertainment that comes from literature.

Writing is a life skill with an array of opportunities to be undertaken outside of school. Writing a short entertaining story, poem, journal diary or even a list, in a birthday card or a letter, can all be strategies to promote the skill of writing at home.

#### **Principals Read Aloud at Home CHALLENGE**

I was so pleased to hand out free books last term to those students who participated in the challenge during Term 1. We look forward to adding more students this Term who are reading on a regular basis and taking control of their reading practise.

A reminder: please listen to your child read for 10 minutes, 3x per week and record or sign either their reading or school diary.


#### **Facilities**


