Questacon

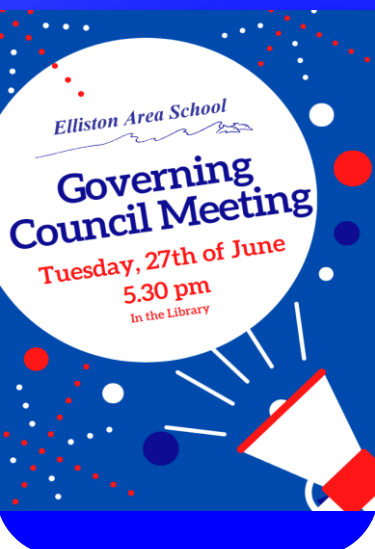
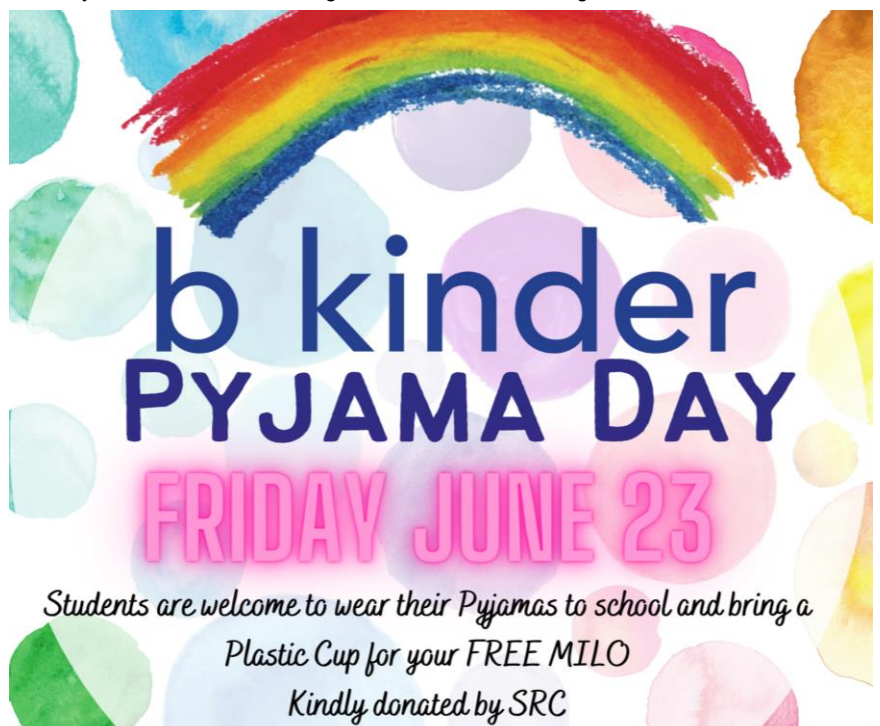

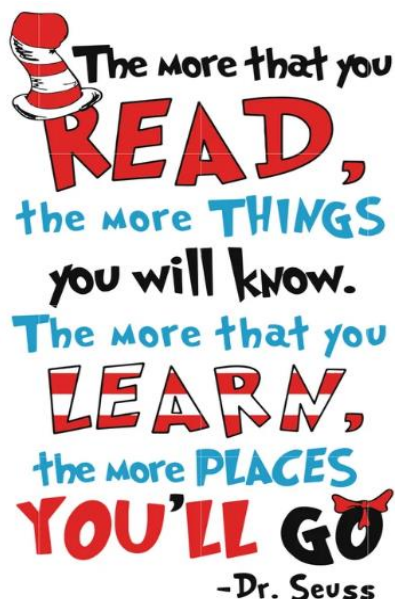
