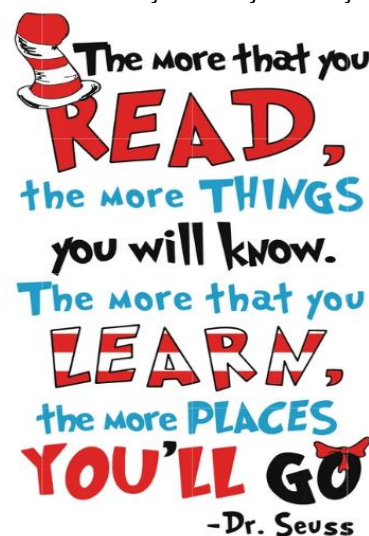

Watercolor Experimentation

Rania researched, planned and executed the art class using the I do, we do, you do model endorsed by the DfE.

Modelling the Technique

Rania explained the purpose of the art lesson, as well as the Learning Intention and the Success Criteria. She talked about the correct use and care of watercolor brushes, and how they need to be cleaned and stored to ensure longevity. Rania explained the importance of using specific brushes for the application of glue, rather than the expensive watercolor brushes.

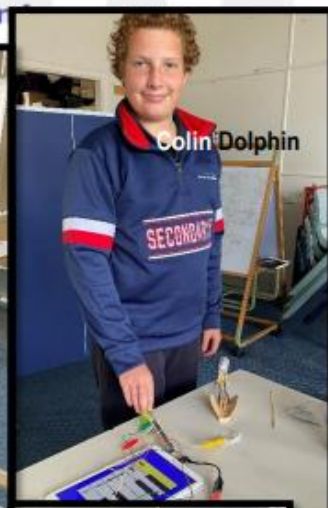

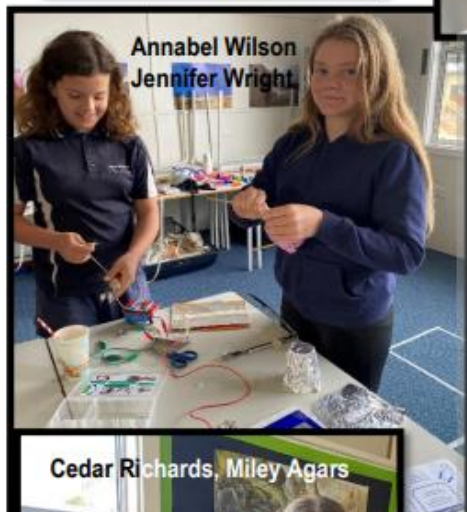
