Hello everyone and Welcome to Week 3. I hope you had a spectacular weekend.

We have another busy week planned of learning as we continue to strive to implement our 2023 Site Improvement Plan strategies. It's exciting to see the reading and writing conferences taking place throughout the school with staff regularly referring to student's goals. The explicit teaching of elements of the Big Six of Reading (oral language, phonological awareness, phonics, vocabulary, fluency and comprehension) as well as writing genre structures, grammar and language convention rules are evident through each classroom.

Initiatives such as the Read Aloud at Home Challenge all contribute to our students expanding their language and literacy skills. Last week 95% of the Year 4/5/6 and 80% of the R/1 class completed 10 minutes of reading 3x during the week. Congratulations to all students who are diligently taking control of their reading development.

### Andy Thomas Space Foundation

We are pleased to inform you that we are participating in the Eyre Peninsula Space Explorers project where our students will work through our Challenge Course in the Makers Empire 3D app (a 3D printing design program). The challenge course includes information about Australia's role in the space industry (including new content focussing on the Eyre Peninsula). Our students will work through a design thinking inquiry based topic or focus area that is locally relevant and will result in a solution designed by the students to solve a space-related problem or challenge, including a 3D-printed element. Mrs R Rom will be working with our classes in Technology lessons to create solutions to the challenges.

### School Values

This week we will be reminding our students of our school values of Respect, Responsibility, Caring, Cooperation and Honesty and how these important attributes influence our safe and exciting learning environment. Over the coming assemblies we will be looking at each value in a little more depth and reminding ourselves of the role we can play as individuals to contribute to making our school a special place to come each day.

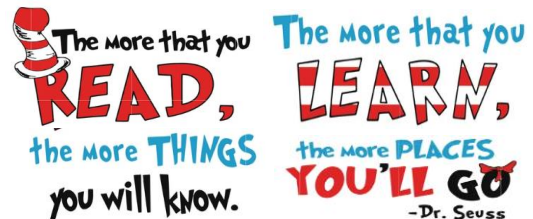

## "Our pup wouldn't hurt a fly."

Last year, over 500 South Australians were admitted to hospital for dog bites because even good dogs have bad days. With some helpful safety tips, many of those injuries could have been avoided. Together let's learn more about dog behaviour and bring this number down.

**Safety tips:**

- ⚠ Always supervise children around dogs at home or in public.
- ⚠ Never enter a dog's territory, like their bed, yard or toy box.
- ⚠ Never startle a dog.
- ⚠ Never touch a dog while it's eating.
- ⚠ Never touch a dog's puppies without the owner's permission.
- ⚠ Never disturb a sleeping dog.
- ⚠ Never put your face near a dog's face.
- ⚠ Teach children to always ask the owner's permission before approaching a dog.
- ⚠ Dogs can bite when they're tired, frightened or annoyed.
- ⚠ When approaching a dog, slowly reach to touch its chest from the side. If it retreats, it's time to back off.
