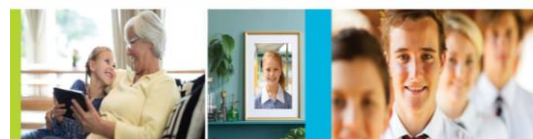

Good Dogs Have Bad Days

"Our pup wouldn't hurt a fly."

Last year, over 500 South Australians were admitted to hospital for dog bites because even good dogs have bad days. With some helpful safety tips, many of those injuries could have been avoided. Together let's learn more about dog behaviour and bring this number down.

Good Dogs Bad Days

From dogs we don't know to the cuddliest family pet, any dog has the potential to bite for all sorts of reasons. So it's vital we know the situations when and why dogs bite and how we can interact with dogs safely.

Safety tips:

- Always supervise children around dogs at home or in public.
- Never enter a dog's territory, like their bed, yard or toy box.
- Never startle a dog.
- Never touch a dog while it's eating.
- Never touch a dog's puppies without the owner's permission.
- Never disturb a sleeping dog.
- Never put your face near a dog's face.
- Teach children to always ask the owner's permission before approaching a dog.
- Dogs can bite when they're tired, frightened or annoyed.
- When approaching a dog, slowly reach to touch its chest from the side. If it retreats, it's time to back off.

IT'S THE LAW!

In South Australia it is compulsory for ALL dogs and cats to be microchipped. All dogs and cats in the District Council of Elliston must be registered in Dogs and Cats Online with the microchipping details.

Dogs and cats must be microchipped:
Before it is sold; or;
Before it reaches 12 weeks of age; or;
Within 28 days of an owner taking possession; or;
If a veterinarian has granted an extension of time, before the extension of time has expired.
