We participated in a Dyslexia Workshop ran by Jo Penna and Tannille Fleming who have both been fortunate enough to attend a Literacy Guarantee Unit led Teacher Learning Community with a specific focus on supporting students with Dyslexia. They discussed the strategies to best support all learners and outlined tools and resources both students and teachers can access to enhance student learning. As we get our teeth into the final Term of 2023 we look forward to sharing with you the learning highlights.


